Summary:

Copper retirements are necessary to respond to various factors in outside plant, including road construction, maintenance problems, customer demand and growth accommodation. Replacement cables will be fiber. Specific information will be provided with each disclosure.

Description of changes in rates, terms or conditions will accompany the planned change(s):

As a general matter, the retirement of copper facilities will not result in changes to rates, terms and conditions in cases where the affected service can be converted to a like-for-like service that is available on the replacement fiber facilities. In cases where interconnecting entities elect to replace the affected service with an alternative service offered on fiber the terms, conditions and rates associated with the replacement service will apply. Blackfoot will provide further information regarding service migration options to affected entities separately from this notice.
