As a provider of interstate telecommunications services, the Blackfoot Communications family of companies ("Blackfoot") are required to contribute to the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF), based on their sales. In turn, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) permits Blackfoot to recover its FUSF contributions from the purchasers of these services in the form of FUSF charges.

In some cases, however, purchasers of Blackfoot services may be exempt from paying FUSF charges under the FCC rules. Services such as a circuit that begins and ends within the state and does not access services such as the internet, or connect to long distance voice services are examples of services that would be exempt. This form is for you to certify your exempt status where the service you are purchasing is technically unable to access any service or areas that leave the state.

If it is determined in the course of an audit that your services are interstate despite your certification, Blackfoot may elect to recover any fees or penalties assessed upon it by the FCC or its administrator from you.
